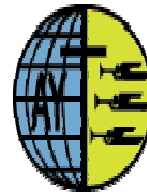
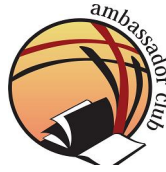

1. Time is essence to life, so every camper need to value time for various programs.
2. No-one is to be found outside or in the rooms during seminar, work - shop classes, worship time, and any activity at the camp without proper reason or permission.
3. During worship services proper dress is advised and encourage.
4. Due to high risk of theft at the camp we advise that you leave your cell phones, radios and any valuable behind for security reasons – if happens you bring it, it is at your own risk and proper care is advised.
5. In all our programs you are asked to make sure that your cell - phones are off and if found playing with a cell phone we will confiscate it until the end of the camp.
6. Eating and drinking during worship time is not allowed.
7. Please do not carry any materials that will lead to harm others and you in the process e.g. drugs, knives, guns, tobacco, fireworks, blowing horns, and alcohol.
8. You are not allowed to go to men's dormitory, if you are a woman and women's dormitory, if you are a man without any authorization of the camp organizers.
9. Leaving of premises will not be allowed only in case of emergency or with parental consultation and the camper organizers will do their level best to supply all basics needs within the vicinity.
10. Use of abusive, insulting, and form of violent language will not be allowed at the camp.
11. Lets' respect sleeping hours by not making unnecessary noise or disturbance.
12. Disciplining of oneself is very crucial not to take something which does not belong to you either purposely or accidentally.
13. All campers are requested to respect each other whether young or old- Respect is earned and not gained by force, experience, or age.
14. Please do not stay at the campus without paying or proper registration.
15. If found guilty by the disciplinarily committee you will be asked to leave the camp and you will forfeit your money – No refunds will be given.
16. We expect all campers to carry their bibles, song books, plates, cups, spoons, beddings, Adventist youth uniform, pathfinders uniform and adventurers uniform, etc.
17. Those under discipline can only be allowed to come this year if cleared by the director and parental engagement.
